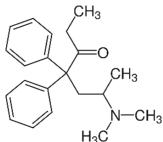

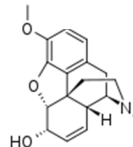

Methadone



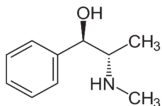
A synthetic drug from the opioid group, used as an analgesic and also in the treatment of drug dependence. Causes morphine-like drug dependence

Codeine



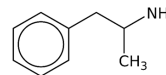
An opium alkaloid, used as an anti-cough drug of central action. It has a mild narcotic (opiate) and analgesic effect

Ephedrine



Psychoactive and poisonous alkaloid that causes (along with pseudoephedrine and N-methylephedrine) narcotic and analgesic effects

Pervitin (methamphetamine)



A psychostimulant with high addictive potential, therefore classified as a narcotic substance.

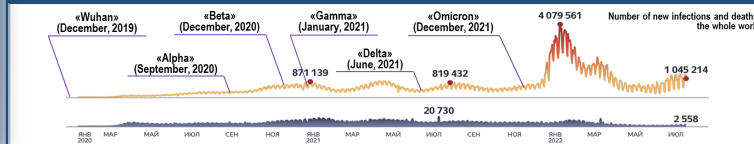

We do not claim that the laboratory manipulations were linked to the emergence of SARS-CoV-2, although clearly they could have been. Nevertheless, we argue that to date there has been no independent and transparent scientific verification of the full body of evidence obtained from the USA..."

REPORT OF THE FORMAL CONSULTATIVE MEETING OF STATES PARTIES TO THE CONVENTION ON THE PROHIBITION OF THE DEVELOPMENT, PRODUCTION AND STOCKPIILING OF BACTERIOLOGICAL (BIOLOGICAL) AND TOXIN WEAPONS AND ON THEIR DESTRUCTION

As agreed at the Informal Meeting held on 11 July 1997 and subsequently confirmed in a Note issued by the Delegates to all States Parties on 8 August 1997, the Formal Consultative Meeting of States Parties to the 1975 Biological Weapons Convention will meet next week in Geneva to hear Cuban allegations that last year the United States discharged the insect pest *Thrips palmi* over Cuba to damage the country's agriculture. The US State Department dismisses the allegations as "outrageous".

The meeting heard statements by the delegates of Cuba and the delegates of the United States, the text of which was circulated to all States Parties participating in the meeting. Both delegations then made a further statement amplifying points raised in their formal statements.

US-Cuba row over insects goes to weapons meeting

[PARIS] The countries that have signed the 1975 Biological Weapons Convention will meet next week in Geneva to hear Cuban allegations that last year the United States discharged the insect pest *Thrips palmi* over Cuba to damage the country's agriculture. The US State Department dismisses the allegations as "outrageous".

The meeting, requested by Russia on behalf of Cuba, will be the first time that the parties to the convention have heard allegations of an infraction of the convention. But the meeting has no power to force further investigations or impose sanctions, because the convention lacks a legally binding verification regime, unlike the Nuclear Non-Proliferation Treaty and the Chemical Weapons Convention. Cuba says it will accept to the treaty have only recently started (see *Nature* 388, 171, 1997).

At most, the meeting could recommend that the United Nations Security Council request an investigation of the allegations, although neither the United States nor Cuba would have any obligation to comply. One official from the US State Department says, however, that the United States would comply if "notification of the case" and wants to act in the spirit of the treaty.

The controversy provides a clear example of why a verification regime is badly needed, says Alastair Hay, a chemical biologist at the University of Leeds in the United Kingdom, and an expert on chemical and biological weapons. Such a regime could have allowed an international inspection team to be sent to Cuba at short notice.

One of biological weapons is "very difficult to prove at the best of times, says Hay, because their effects may be indistinguishable from natural outbreaks of disease. Adding to the uncertainty is the difficulty of verifying claims so long after the alleged incident, which is said to have occurred on 21 October 1996.

Cuba alleges that on this day a State Department aircraft designed to eradicate malaria mosquitoes, which had been authorized to spray Cuba, sprayed an area known as the Chiron corridor, where an epidemic of palm thrips broke out a few weeks later...
